








Moon Cakes are a traditional treat shared between friends and families during the Moon Festival!

And that's why people say Chang Er is up there, watching over us from the moon!








Make a Moon Festival Lantern Craft Lanterns are a special part of Moon Festiva


Lanterns are a special part of Moon Festival. Celebrate by making your own! When you are done, hold your lantern, look up at the big round moon with your family and make a wish!
